Fabric Donation Acceptance Policy

Thank you for contacting the NNMQG regarding the donation of fabric. We are currently accepting only **100% cotton fabric in cuts 1 yard and up**. Please email Dru Hammond at <u>druhammond@aol.com</u> to arrange a donation.

Although we do not accept fabric less than 1 yard in length or fabric that is not 100% cotton, there are some local places where you may be able to give it to someone who can make use of it.

- Buy Nothing Santa Fe and Circle of Giving are both Facebook groups where you can give items away to other members of the group. There is no cost to list your items. We suggest that large collections of fabrics and sewing items be broken down into smaller groups for donating on either of these platforms. Tip: A few grocery sacks of fabric are more likely to be taken than 3 garbage bags of disorganized fabric.
- If you are not on Facebook, **Craig's List** is another alternative for giving away things for free. Simply Google it to get started.
- Resourceful Santa Fe will also accept donations of fabric of all kinds and do not specify a minimum size for fabrics. They can be contacted at www.resourcefulsantafe.com. Normal hours for donations are Tuesday afternoons between 1:30 and 4:00 at 2879A Industrial Road in Santa Fe.
